# February 2022 – HCCA National Convention & Tour

Trees and Kim Simoni had the pleasure of attending and participating in this year's National HCCA Convention & Tour in Howey-In-The-Hills, Florida! "The hills in Florida?", you say?! Well, actually yes! Not many, and not very high, but a few rollers! One day we toured over the highest point in Florida, at 345 feet above sea level 😊 And, lakes EVERYWHERE! Gorgeous country!



We arrived at The Mission Inn & Resort in Howey-In-The-Hills (45 minutes south of Orlando) on Saturday February 19, late (we flew there directly from Dubai, having visited family the week prior; 16 hours non-stop on an airplane and a 9-hour time zone change!).

The Convention kicked off Sunday evening with a BBQ dinner at the hotel. We estimate 65 pre-16 automobiles and about 130+ people in attendance! It was GREAT to see everyone again. Most all were vaccinated and social distancing was observed (somewhat!).

Touring occurred Monday through Friday. Miles/day ranged from 35 to 75 and included ice cream stops every afternoon. We visited an alpaca farm, a miniature donkey farm and went on a paddle-wheeler (Dora Queen) boat ride on Lake Dora. We walked through an extraordinary Farmall tractor collection (200+ tractors!), and checked out (yes, imbibed) at many local craft breweries and tap rooms along the way.



Trees and I were "ride-alongs", as we didn't have our Pennsylvania car in Florida, but decided it was terrific to just be able to look around and not be responsible for navigating, driving and any mechanicals! Super easy to wrangle a ride every day!

Friday evening was the General Membership meeting where awards were given out and the event wrapped up with a fabulous buffet dinner for all. We flew home from Orlando on Saturday morning and it was LOVELY to return home. However, if you ever have the opportunity to attend a National Convention & Tour, do so! We thoroughly enjoyed

ourselves and again made many new friends in the hobby!

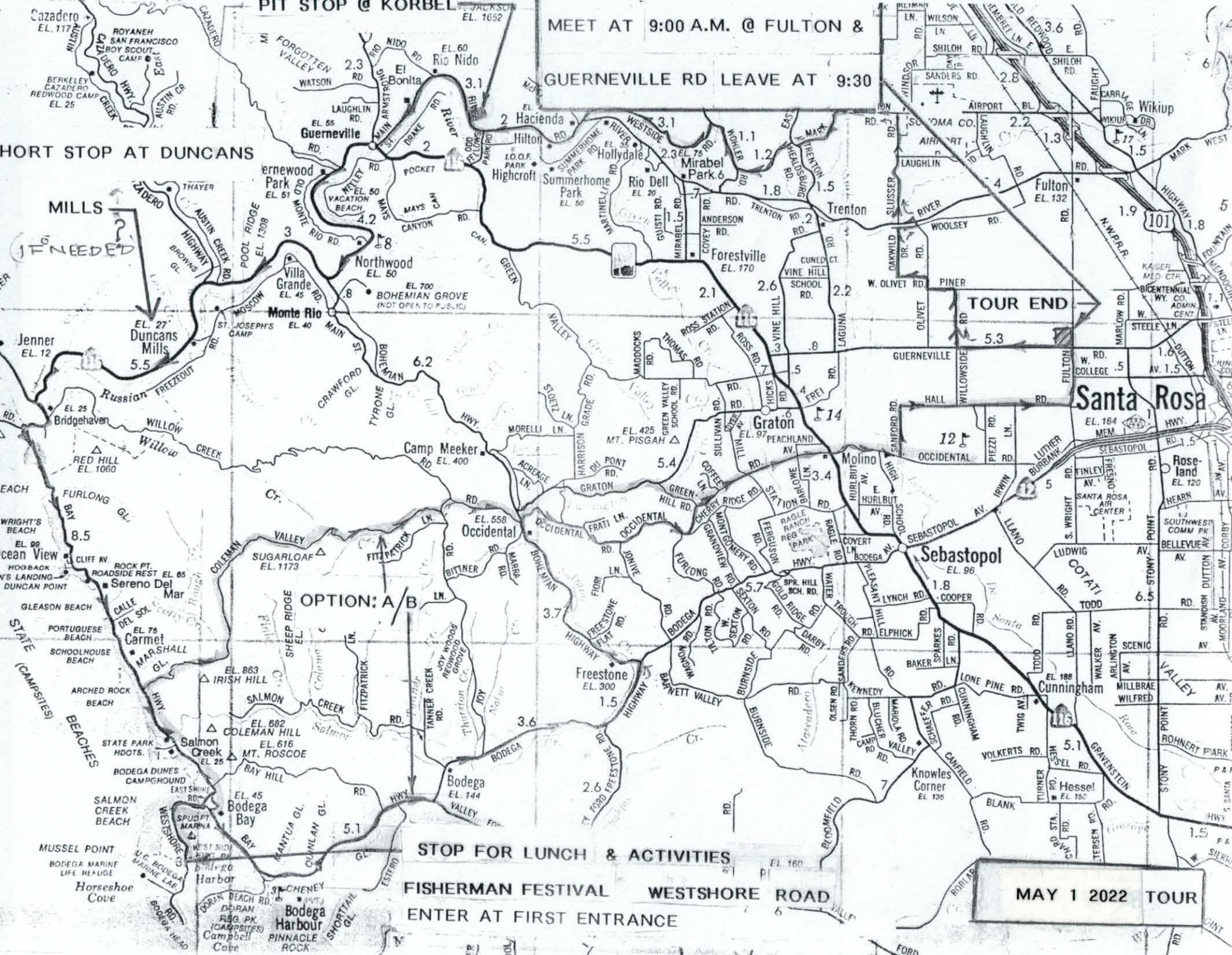
