We met at Pacific Market in Sebastopol and headed west out Green Valley Road, Mays Canyon and Westside road to Healdsburg.

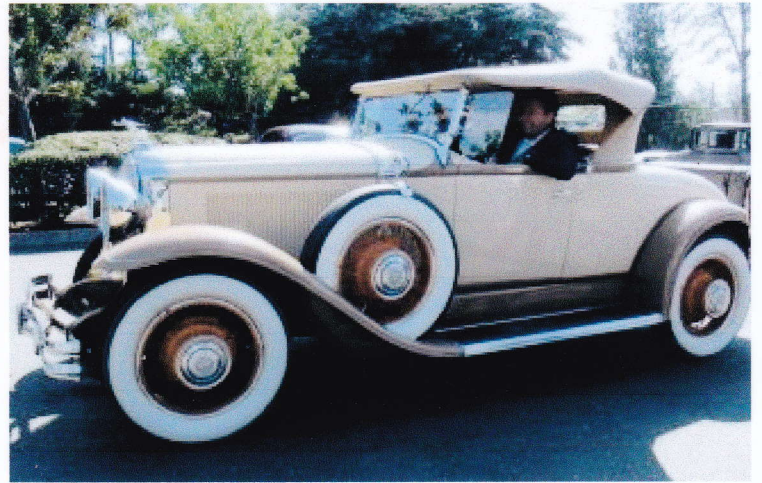
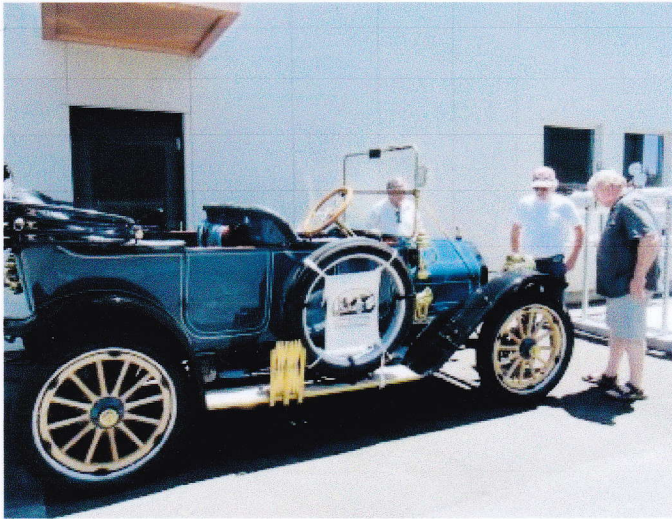

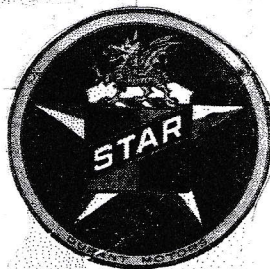
