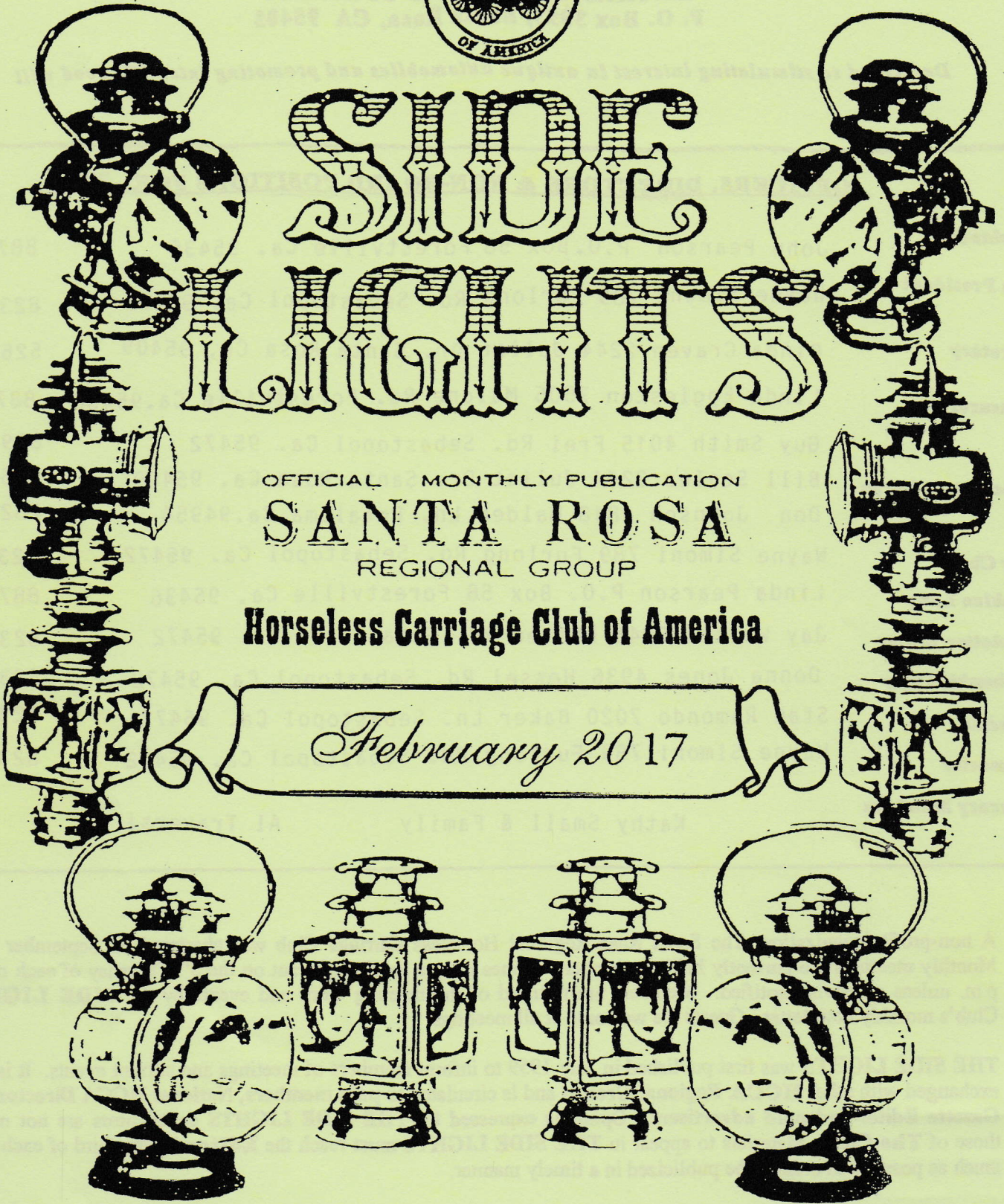

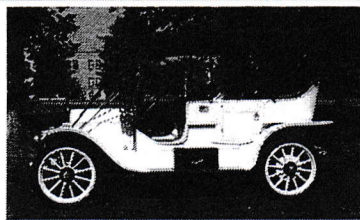

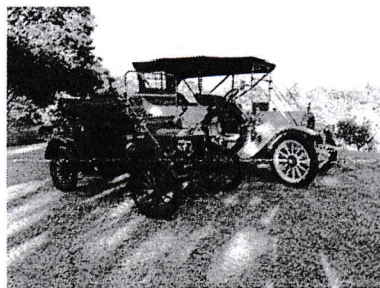
I hope the following will help increase participation:

Headquarters will be at Murphys Suites in the beautiful California Foothills town of Murphys, Calaveras County. Angels Camp RV Resort is 9.9 miles away (sorry, we could not find a good RV park closer). Tour cost is \$210.00 per person and includes one evening supper (Sunday), banquet (Thursday night), and four tour day lunches (cost for children, depending on age, by request). A hospitality room will be available for daily and evening social times, including snacks and refreshments. Evening meals (Monday through Wednesday) will be on your own. Breakfast, consisting of orange juice, doughnut and coffee is provided by the hotel.
