- **HCCA Information and Documents Project** Over the past year, we have been working on developing, creating and storing digital documents for visitors, members and directors that visit the HCCA web site. During the past year, the delivery time line was expanded to address and fix gaps in information by finding answers to common questions.
 - So far over 60 documents have been created and saved to digital documents and or picture files.
 - A master document describing the content of the project has been created that identifies the content and organization of website storage pages - Topic "folder groups", Titles, descriptions, Document file name, and access limitation (World, HCCA Members, Directors).
 - The web site **Test** pages have been created (they are not yet viewable by members) for storage of the files. The next step is to install the files in the test area and test the viewing.

Tours: We might do a last minute lunch tour in March, weather permitting. The Fisherman's Festival is scheduled for April 9.

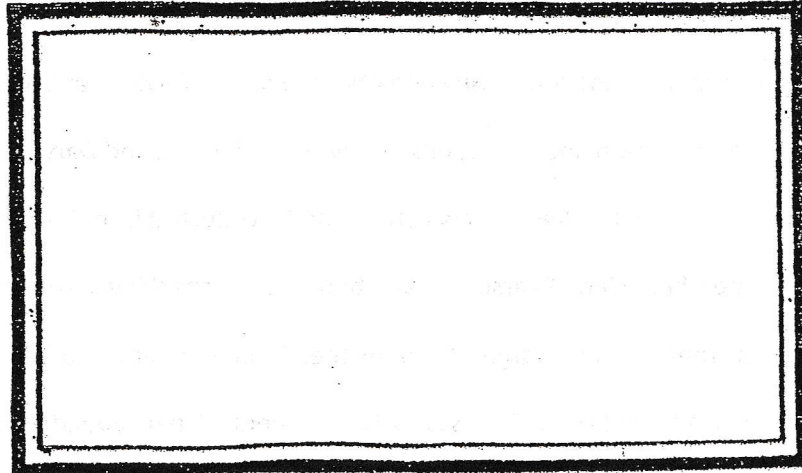

Stories: Guy and Michelle are going to Tehachapi to purchase a 1931 Model A 4- door sedan.

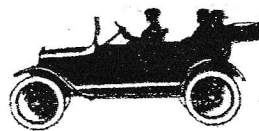

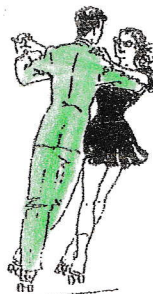
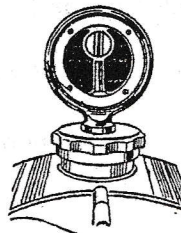
