

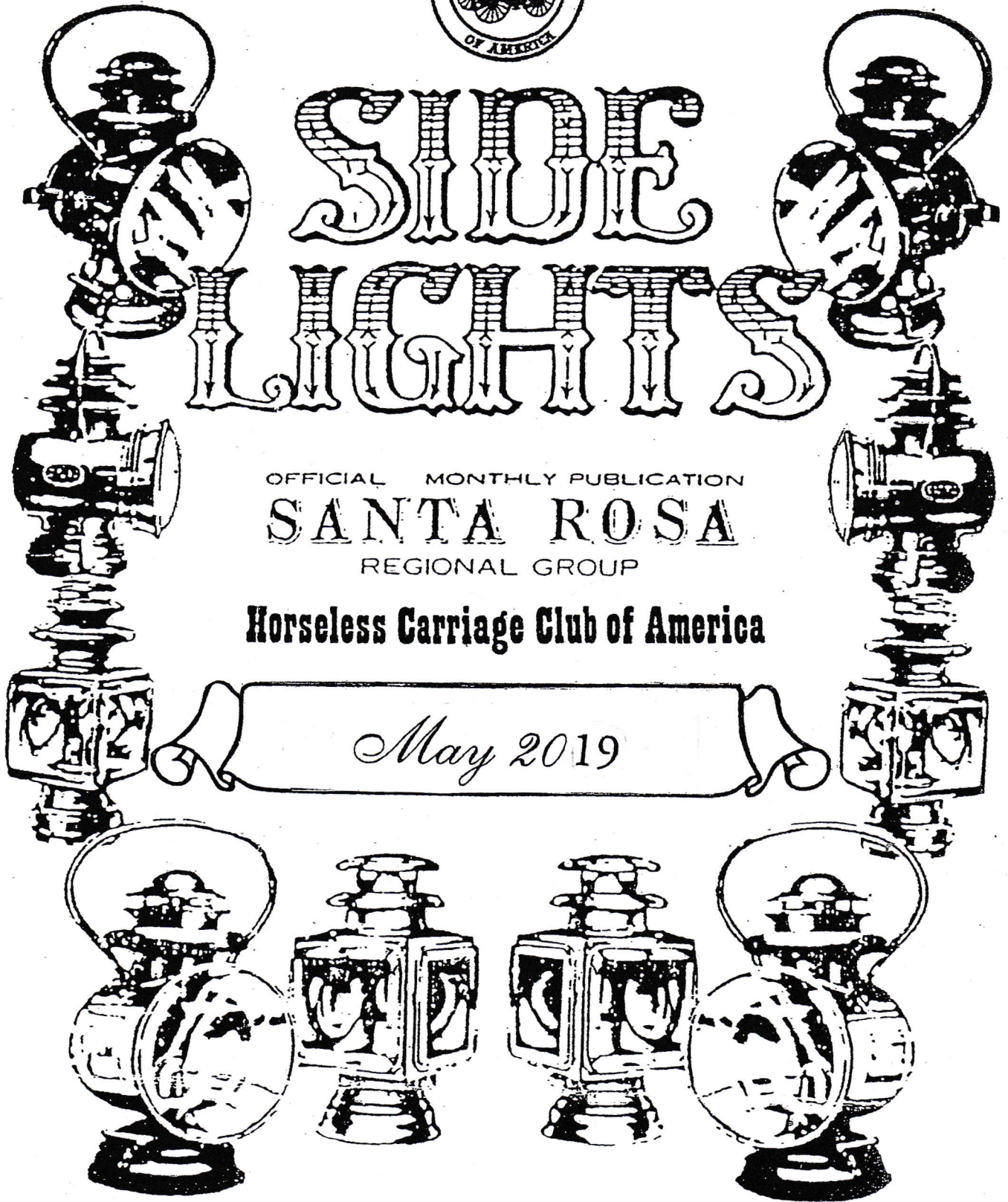

SIMONI TOUR 2019

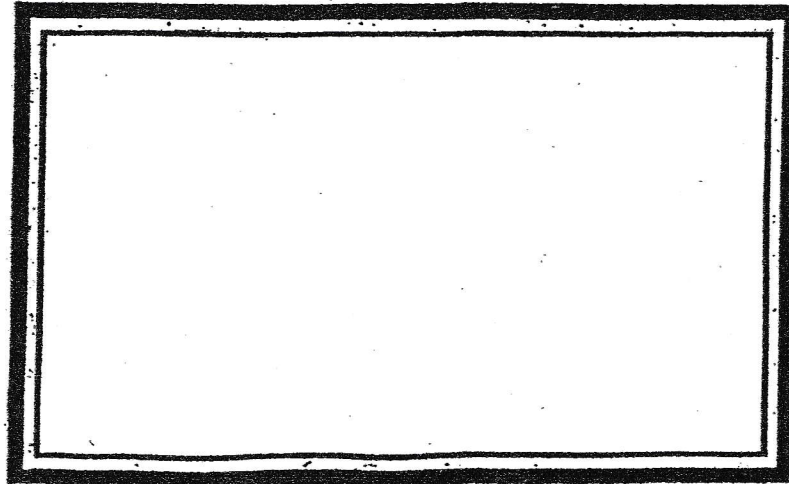

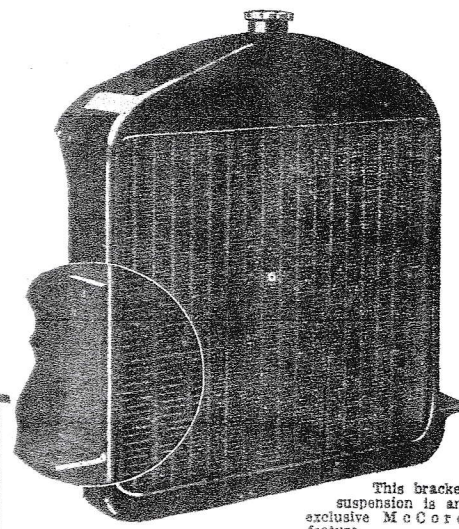
