GREASE CUPS

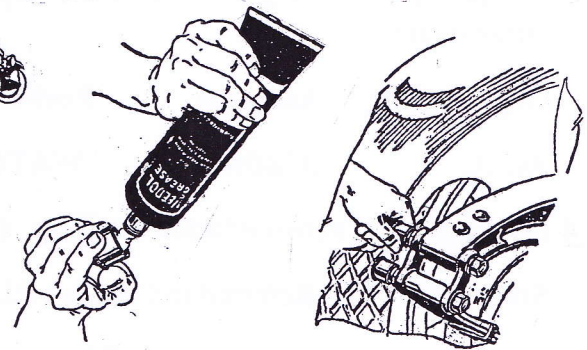
Beyond a doubt the chassis lubrication system of the present will soon make way for one central lubrication system—a system which is fool-proof and automatic. Until that time we will have to bear with what we have no matter how distasteful we find it.

If you have no lubrication diagram for your particular make and year of car, you should make it a point to get one from your service station.

It is necessary that the grease cups on your car be filled and turned down at definite intervals.

Remember this: wherever there is a moving part there is friction, and where there is friction there is bound to be a certain amount of wear.

And the wear in your bearing surfaces can only be reduced to a minimum through proper lubrication.



And the motorist who does not take the trouble to turn down his grease cups, or have it done for him, is the motorist who pays many times over in parts replacements for his neglect.

At the first filling, fill all grease cups and turn them down as far as possible, or until grease shows through the lubricated surfaces.

When cups have been completely turned down, refill them and screw on a few turns to prevent their rattling off. One or two turns should suffice for lubricating after the first filling.
